Elementary Summer Learning:

Polk County will be offering a K-5 summer learning program from June 19-June 30 at Polk County Middle School. The program will be offered to students who are at-risk and will address learning losses and negative impacts students have experienced due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Grades K-2 Reading & Math Instruction
- Grades 3-5 Reading, Math, & Science Instruction
- Food Service will provide breakfast and lunch
- Transportation will be provided from the individual elementary school locations
- Enrichment activities will be provided

Middle School Summer Offerings:

Polk County Middle School will be offering a summer learning program from June 19-June 30 for current 6th and 7th graders. The program will be offered to students who are at-risk and will address learning losses and negative impacts students have experienced due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Grades 6-7 Reading & Math Instruction
- Food Service will provide breakfast and lunch
- Enrichment activities will be provided

Rising 6th graders will be invited to “Jumpstart” in August. Students will enjoy learning about the middle school team teaching model and will be active in team-building relationships while becoming familiar with the layout of the building.

High School Summer

The CTE construction department will work with a small group(5-10) of students to work on maintenance and building projects on the PCHS campus. The teacher will provide direct instruction and on-the-job training for participants. Students will work on-site for a minimum of 50 hours. Projects include new ramps on the portable units and a fence for the Exceptional Children's Department.
