TRIP OVERVIEW:

The NCFFA Camp will be held June 3-7 in Elizabethtown, North Carolina. The Polk County FFA Chapter will leave June 3rd and return June 7th.

Forty-two students will be representing the Polk County High School FFA Chapter in the senior.

STUDENT and CHAPERONE COST:

Expenses:
