TRIP OVERVIEW:

The 2025 North Carolina HOSA State Leadership Conference will be held on Wednesday, March 26, 2025 through Friday, March 28, 2025, at the Sheraton Four Seasons in Greensboro, NC; located at 3121 W Gate City Blvd, Greensboro, NC 27407.

The purpose of the event is to stimulate learning activities relative to health science including behavioral health and medical terminology. Skills such as recognizing and responding to mental health emergencies as well as preventative health and terminology will be incorporated.

Two teams will be allowed to compete in this year's competition: a behavioral health team and an individual qualifier for medical terminology. Therefore, four students will be representing the Polk County High School HOSA Chapter at this event (three members on the behavioral health team and one member on the medical terminology team).

STUDENT and CHAPERONE COST:

Expenses:

- Registration fees (\$85 per student & advisor) - \$425
- Two Hotel Rooms/three nights at State Rate (including chaperone room) - \$163 plus tax per room at Sheraton Four Seasons, Greensboro, NC - \$978 plus tax total
- Teacher Meals – \$138.99
- Fuel for Expedition

FUNDRAISING:

Students with financial needs will be funded with these fundraisers and through Polk HOSA as needed. No child will be refused this trip because of an inability to pay.

- Career and Technical Education Funds will be used for the teacher room, meals, transportation and student registration.
- Students' meals will be paid for themselves (approximately \$150), unless they lack the funds, at which time the Polk County HOSA Chapter will provide their meals.
